

A Dance for Margaret

32 Bar Jig for 4 couples

- 1 - 4 1st Lady and 4th Man set, 1st Lady cast off, 4th Man cast up, 2nd Lady and 3rd Man step up or down on bars 3 and 4
- 5 - 8 1st Lady and 4th Man turn right hand one and half times to finish 1st Lady in 3rd Mans place 4th Man in 2nd Ladies place, *at the same time* 1st Man and 4th Lady set, 1st Man cast off, 4th Lady cast up, 2nd Man and 3rd Lady step up or down on bars 7 and 8
- 9 - 12 1st Man and 4th Lady turn right and one and half times to finish 1st Man in 3rd Ladies place 4th Lady in 2nd Mans place
- 13 - 16 1st and 4th couples joining hands on the sidelines set, 4th couple cast up 1st couple cast off, 2nd and 3rd couples step up or down on bars 15 and 16
- 17 - 20 4th and 2nd couples dance half rights and lefts
- 21 - 24 4th and 3rd couples dance half rights and lefts
- 25 - 32 All dance back to back, all turn partner right hand one and half times to own side.

Repeat three more times.

Those who know Margaret well, know that she enjoys "Birling" at every opportunity. As this dance was devised for her, I felt that she should have the opportunity to "Birl". Therefore, you may substitute a pivot turn (birl) instead of turning right hand one and a half times as described in the instructions.
